Phone or visit restaurant to :-

- Assess capacity (minimum of 30)
- Decide on a date. (See restrictions above.)
- Strike a deal on a menu. (Most people are happy with \$40-45 for a dinner, \$35-40 for a lunch.)
- Get the details of the menu. (Courses? Are tea and coffee included?)
- Find out whether Licensed or BYO. (If BYO, find out any corkage cost.)
- Payment can be made via your or Co-ordinator's credit card and re-imbursement sought from the Treasurer. (Find out if there is a fee for using a credit card.)
- Assess parking facilities or public transport arrangements.

Provide the Dinner Co-ordinator with all the above information.

Co-ordinator will handle all Newsletter publicity.

Co-ordinator and Treasurer will handle member's payments.

Co-ordinator will provide you with a final list of attendees and the final payment amount.

GENEALOGY

How to start your own family history research

Do you need help with your own family history research? I can provide information about software that can be bought for you to record your family history details and documents, on your own computer. You will be able to print out your ancestor and descendent trees.

I can provide information about the tools available for researching BDMs (births, deaths and marriages), immigrants and convicts, as well as UK censuses from 1841 to 1911 and UK parish and civil registrations of BDMs from early 1700s to the 20th century. You don't need to leave Australia to do it. And your research can be done on your home computer, much of it for free. But you will need to visit libraries, use the internet and send letters and emails. I've got details of the right websites and the right indexes where you can research the information you need.

Members should not hesitate to contact me if they have any questions about family history research they may be doing, or have hit a roadblock with their research, or they get to the stage of asking themselves "What do I do next?" Just send me an email, or letter, or phone me and I'll see what help and suggestions I can make. No charge.

After morning tea in the cafe we headed off to "Botanica" It is a biennial exhibition by Australia's leading Botanical artists. The Exhibition was titled "The Art of Disguise and Deception." This year it was held in the new Gallery in the recently renovated former Herbarium. We were amazed by the intricate detailed work. Many would have taken hundreds of hours to complete.

We next dropped into the Growing Friend nursery in the garden. It has many rare, unusual and endangered plants for sale. Some people took the opportunity to get a few for their gardens.

Then we made our way up to the Calyx for the new Exhibition there. "Alchemy of a Rainforest". This featured spectacular rare and unusual tropical and subtropical rainforest plants. We were also amazed by garden sculptures that had been crafted from repurposed waste. A highlight was the oversized Satin Bowerbird's bower crafted from upcycled materials.

The Calyx boasts the largest walled garden in the Southern Hemisphere.

Then it was time to find some lunch which proved challenging. Our first preference, The Calyx didn't have enough seating. The next at the library had sold out of food. Fortunately those who headed down Hunter Street had success but those in Martin Place were not so successful. It was a tired group who eventually made their way to the Metro and home.

March Outing – Riverside Theatres

On the 31st March 19 members met at the Riverside Theatre complex at Parramatta for a tour of the facility.

For some of us getting there was an experience in itself since for a few it was their first experience of the Carlingford Light Rail - and they loved it!

We were met by Amy (who hosts many of the groups who visit the complex) and Sean, one of the technical gurus.

We were taken into the smallest of the 3 theatres, the Rafferty, with a capacity of 88 seats. It closely resembled a lecture theatre, but is used for both cinema as well as the more intimate styles of presentation, including music.

Next we were taken into the 213-seat Lennox theatre, and then via dressing rooms and the cramped backstage areas (space is very limited!) into the largest theatre, the Riverside (761 seats). Hear we learned about some of the more interesting technical aspects of running a show like managing scene changes, arranging the seating to cater for an orchestra pit, and so on.

In September the Riverside is to be completely "re-jigged" to current theatre building standards while the 2 smaller theatres will be demolished to make way for a much larger (1500+ seats) theatre where large scale musicals, concerts and the like can be put on (not possible with the current configurations).

Our tour was meant to last only 1 hour, but it actually went a little over 90 minutes – a reflection I think not only of members' interest, but also of the love of the place shown by our guides.

We cannot wait to see what the new Riverside will be like!



This will ensure that the leader is aware of your intention to participate and thus avoid disappointment of potentially missing out on the activity.
