The meeting of the Book club of Westleigh Combined Probus club met after the General Meeting on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> June. 12 members attended.

The book discussed was called "The Night Guest". It was about an ageing widow, Ruth, who is widowed, her sons are grown, and she lives in an isolated beach house outside of town. Her routines are few and small. One day a stranger arrives at her door, looking as if she has been blown in from the sea. This woman—Frida—claims to be a care worker sent by the government. Ruth lets her in.

Now that Frida is in her house, is Ruth right to fear the tiger she hears on the prowl at night, far from its jungle habitat? Why do memories of childhood in Fiji press upon her with increasing urgency? How far can she trust this mysterious woman, Frida, who seems to carry with her, her own troubled past? And how far can Ruth trust herself?

Ruth also reconnects with a man from her past when she lived in Fiji. She wants to remain independent, but can she?

All this is hard for Ruth as she finds it difficult to distinguish the past from the present. And all is not as it seems.

Most members found the book interesting, but some did not. But that's part of belonging to a book club. I doubt if any of us would have picked this book up from the library to read ourselves.

The book for this month is one written by Richard Flanagan called "Question 7". It is his latest book written in 2023.

I have read the book, yet I still cannot see why it is called that! Maybe in our meeting a member might be able to enlighten me!

The story moves from his father's life at the time of the bombing of Hiroshima (where his father was working as a slave labourer) to Richard's life with his father and his family.

He also intersperses his father's life with H.G.Wells' affair with Rebecca West through 1930 when nuclear physics was being developed.

Then at the end of the story the author goes back to when he nearly drowned in Tasmania when he was 21 but managed to survive.

- Get the details of the menu. (Courses? Are tea and coffee included?)
- Find out whether Licensed or BYO. (If BYO, find out any corkage cost.)
- Payment can be made via your or Co-ordinator's credit card and re-imbursement sought from the Treasurer. (Find out if there is a fee for using a credit card.)
- Assess parking facilities or public transport arrangements.

Provide the Dinner Co-ordinator with all the above information. Co-ordinator will handle all Newsletter publicity.

Co-ordinator and Treasurer will handle member's payments.

Co-ordinator will provide you with a final list of attendees and the final payment amount.

#### GENEALOGY

How to start your own family history research

Do you need help with your own family history research?

I can provide information about software that can be bought for you to record your family history details and documents, on your own computer. You will be able to print out your ancestor and descendent trees.

I can provide information about the tools available for researching BDMs (births, deaths and marriages), immigrants and convicts, as well as UK censuses from 1841 to 1911 and UK parish and civil registrations of BDMs from early 1700s to the 20th century. You don't need to leave Australia to do it. And your research can be done on your home computer, much of it for free. But you will need to visit libraries, use the internet and send letters and emails. I've got details of the right websites and the right indexes where you can research the information you need.

Members should not hesitate to contact me if they have any questions about family history research they may be doing, or have hit a roadblock with their research, or they get to the stage of asking themselves "What do I do next?" Just send me an email, or letter, or phone me and I'll see what help and suggestions I can make. No charge.

After our tour we enjoyed lunch in The Gallery Cafe and then made the trip home.


#### **Other Outings**





This will ensure that the leader is aware of your intention to participate and thus avoid disappointment of potentially missing out on the activity.
